Kidz Que Schedule – Friday, May 21, 2010

Upon Arrival, check in at the designated Kidz Que area.

Location of Event: Capital Federal Park @ Sandstone Ampitheater 622 North 122 rd Street

4:30pm – check-in–grills will be started

5:00pm – Kidz(5-10) cooks meeting

5:15pm – Kidz (5-10)start cooking

5:45pm – Kidz que turn-in

6:00pm – Kidz(11-15) cooks meeting

6:15pm – Kidz (11-15)start cooking

6:45pm – Kidz que turn-in

7:15pm – Awards ceremony – judging tent

Kidz Que Rules:

1. There will be two age group distinctions:

Group 1: age 5 thru age 10 – will cook pork chop provided by GAB

Group 2: age 11 thru age 15 – will cook steak provided by GAB

Each entry will consist of only 1 entrant/cook

2. Preparation, cooking and presentation: The child must do the preparation, cooking and preparation, cooking and presentation. Parents may help with fires and slicing or anything considered dangerous. If a child is unable to do all of the above on his own, he is too young to cook.
3. Handicapped children need not be eliminated from competition, but will be allowed to do as much as they are able with some help from an assigned person.
4. All children will cook in a designated area on grills provided by the Great American Barbecue Contest(GAB). Families with more than one child participating can cook on the same grill if they choose.
5. A parent/guardian must be present with the child during the entire cooking process.
6. Entries will be submitted in numbered containers approved by the GAB.
7. Garnish is provided by the GAB. (Green leaf lettuce)
8. Slicing meat for presentation is not required. Judges will be equipped to slice the presentation at the judging table.
9. Judging will be based on APPEARANCE, TENDERNESS/TEXTURE AND TASTE.
10. Judging ranges are from nine(9) being the highest to one(1) being the lowest.
11. Kidz need to bring their own spices and cooking utensils.
12. Kidz do not need to cut the meat for the judges, as judges will be supplied with knives.
13. No coolers or alcohol will be allowed in the kidz que area

Special Instructions for Kidz Que:

Pork Chop: The pork chop will be provided by the GAB and must be used in the competition.

Steak: The steak will be provided by the GAB and must be used in the competition.
